Dear Friends,
 We've been at this a long time. This past year marked Chizuk Amuno Congregation's 140th anniversary, an impressive milestone of communal longevity and achievement. We chose this celebration for three reasons. We wanted to honor the past, cherish the present, and most importantly, create the future.

As we turned 140, we were cognizant that we are living through a significant generational turn. In a cyclical view of history it seems that every eighty years or so, as if parallel to the four approximately twenty year phases of our life journeys from childhood to adulthood, from mid-life to elder hood, societies enter eras of challenge, change, and renewal. That's where we are right now, arriving at the next moment.

Given the shock waves of economic recession and financial strain, watching the upheaval in political discourse, and observing the weakening of social institutions - including the synagogue, we live our days enveloped by the constant commotion of social evolution. There is a gap between generations and worldviews. In Jewish community, the next generation desires different models for their Jewish expression.

During Chizuk Amuno's 140th year, we thought about all of this. We asked ourselves what we need from our synagogue in the 21st century and began to craft our answers. We also celebrated some wonderful milestones as we marked the 50th anniversary of our Sanctuary, the 10th anniversary of the Goldsmith Museum, Sisterhood's 125th anniversary, and Krieger Schechter Day School's 30th anniversary. Perhaps most exciting, hundreds of synagogue families wrote letters in our 140th anniversary *Torah*.

In *Torah*, Moses receives gifts to erect the *Mishkan*, the portable wilderness Tabernacle. These contributions were called "Terumat HaKodesh - Sacred Gifts." This is how we at Chizuk Amuno Congregation understand each donation, as a *terumat hakodesh* - a sacred gift. Your gifts sustain our community and provide for all of our needs.



We offer varied and creative programs, focused on our vision of becoming a sacred community and our mission of putting Jewish values and ideas into practice. 

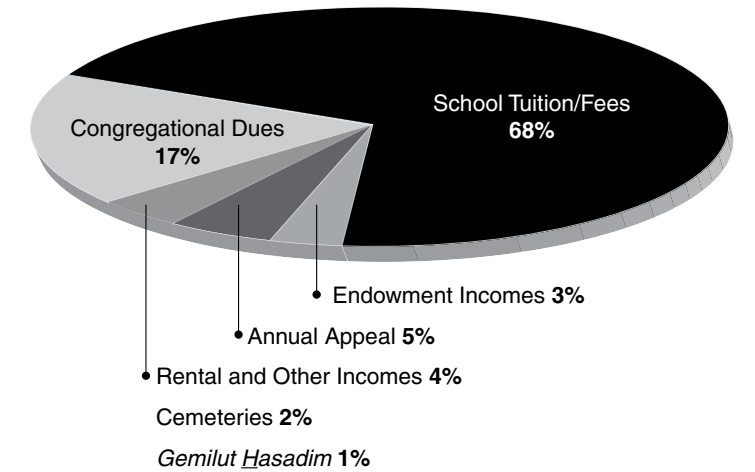

Chizuk Amuno's 140th Anniversary

This year marked the 140th Anniversary of Chizuk Amuno's founding. Our community celebrated our accomplishments and charted the course for the next decade. Each month was full of milestone celebrations, unique learning, worship, and service programs that brought hundreds of families into our building and onto our campus, engaging them in synagogue life in new and meaningful ways.

We took as our theme for the 140th year words spoken by King David as he charged his son Solomon and all the officers of Israel.

David wanted to build a Temple in Jerusalem that would honor God and serve the people. At the end of the Bible, in the Book of Chronicles, we read that he was not allowed to carry out this project. "The word of the Eternal God came to me, saying, '...you shall not build a House for My name for you have shed much blood on the earth in My sight.'"

In this application of Jewish ethics, David is disqualified from his sacred task. The ancient Temple, as our modern synagogue, must represent a community's most worthy religious aspirations and hopes. So King David turns to Solomon, provides him with the resources, craftsmen, and workers he'll need and instructs him to build the Temple.

קום וְצִוֵּה "Koom v'aseh, Arise and create, and may the Eternal God be with you."

In Hebrew numerology the letter **ק**—*koof* represents 100, the letter **מ**—*mem* equals 40. In our 140th year, we sought to "Arise and Create" a synagogue community representing our most worthy religious aspirations and hopes.



Arise and Create: Torah

February 13, 2011 was a historic moment at Chizuk Amuno. The Sanctuary was overflowing with joy as our community leaders wrote the first letters in Chizuk Amuno's 140th Anniversary *Torah*. Generations came together in song and prayer as we began this year-long journey. After the *shofar* blasts filled the Sanctuary and our *Sifrei Torah* were paraded down the aisle for all to see, Rabbi Shulman wrote the first letter of *B'reishit* on behalf of the congregation. A highlight of the Opening Ceremony was the performance of Debbie Friedman's *L'chi Lach* by the Chizuk Amuno Community Choir, led by Bob Hallock and comprised of over 200 members of our school and synagogue communities.

Throughout the months that followed, synagogue community members joined our *sofer*, scribe, Rabbi Moshe Druin in completing the 613th *mitzvah* of writing a letter in the *Torah*. Over 450 families have written or are scheduled to write a letter. Our new *Torah* will be a "living" *Torah*, created by our community and used to teach our congregants the foundations of our faith. This *Sefer Torah* will be used by generations to come as they, too, develop their partnership with God and our community.

Restricted funds provide scholarships for Krieger Schechter Day School, Rosenbloom Religious School, Jewish camps, and Israel programs; stipends for professional development; income for capital maintenance; special program lectures; and support for social service and educational programs. We are indebted to those who generously funded the original concept in 1987 and to all those individuals, families, and foundations who have since joined our earliest donors to assure the future financial stability and viability of Chizuk Amuno.
